## ***Juggling is Catching -- Things and Ideas!***

**Adaptable for grades 4-12; class length 45 min. or customized to host's schedule.**  
**Curriculum -- Physical Education, Math, Information and Communications Skills, Thinking and Reasoning Skills**

Bring physical intelligence into your classroom. This workshop will improve the body awareness of your students as they learn to use all their abilities when tackling problems. Juggling is a way to wake up the whole student body. Your students will learn how to be more confident in their physical presence. Juggling will help them to see in a physical way, how their bodies like to think and react. Your students will learn how to catch different items when people throw things at them - from a ball to a verbal problem! This workshop will be an opportunity for all students, including those who have difficulty processing abstract information, the shine as they react kinetically to problem solving. Everyone will learn how to think on their feet!

## ***My First Short Story***

**Adaptable for grades 4-12; class length 45 min. or customized to host's schedule.**  
**Curriculum -- Language Arts, Literature, Physical Education**

Let's get up from our desks! Come explore creative writing from a new perspective. We will spark young imaginations by using our entire body as we collaborate together. In this workshop we will engage in animated reading of stories by Chris Van Allsburg, Calef Brown, Shel Silverstein and others, as they inspire us to write our own stories. Group improvisation, Mime, and Storytelling exercises will help us improve our collaboration skills and bring the class closer together as a team. Students will take home a copy of their original short story.
